# We should all be prepared for emergencies. Knowing what to do in advance can mean the difference between life and death.

## Stay Informed:

• Register your cell phones with Alert San Diego (<u>www.readysandiego.org</u>) to receive reverse 911 calls during emergencies

- Sign up for official information (Twitter, Facebook, Nixle, etc.)
- Visit the Heartland Fire website for information: www.heartlandfire.org
- If you or someone in your family has any situation that requires additional planning, make sure that you take that into consideration when developing your disaster plan/supplies. Stay informed on what additional supplies are recommended or how you need to plan
- Identify how local authorities will notify you during a disaster and how you will get important information
- Listen to AM 600 KOGO radio for official emergency information
- Be informed of how to respond to minor medical emergencies, sign-up to take a first aid and CPR class.
- Dial 2-1-1 for community and non-emergency, disaster information
